Skarnikat is an entertainer that has performed for numerous Probus Clubs, a specialist in the classics, well-suited to our demographic of age. He is also a speaker, educator, author and regular columnist in senior -focused Respect

News. He performs nearly 500 concerts per year in retirement homes of all kinds across Canada. He lives in Hanover and left really early to get here in time. It's has been 73 months since he performed here in Wasaga Beach for one of the ladies' clubs. He did 490 concerts in 2023, all but 9 were for retirement homes.

He's been studying retirement living for 35 years and used to be a nutritional advisor until he realized he was working in a hot kitchen while everyone was having fun and so he changed his future and work life. He has been playing for 15 years for retirees and in 2 weeks he will do his 3000th concert. He has a Facebook page and You tube station and makes various videos to provide entertainment when not performing in person. All of his focus is on the retiree demographic. Home Care Canada, a senior care organization, pays Jimmy to market their services during his concerts. His music tends to concentrate on happy sentiments to uplift his audience. He lost about 1000 concerts due to the pandemic. He sang Happy Birthday and recorded our group singing along for his You tube channel.

SPECIAL GUEST: DISTRICT 7 DIRECTOR



Martin Buscher, Manager Ontario District 7, gave us an overview of what **Probus Canada** provides for its member clubs and members.

At the top of the list is member and officer liability insurance that helps keep us safe against legal actions and injury while on Probus business.

Probus Canada has a Gen-

eral Manager that oversees the ordering process for Probus branded items such as pins and apparel. The General Manager also organizes the Board of Directors meetings. Probus brings in, as needed, a financial advisor to ensure the books are in good order. It uses Google for advertising and meeting software. Probus has various providers that supply health, travel, home and auto insurance for units' members, Probus receives payment from these providers for this service.

Probus has developed a reference guide to help newcomers navigate club needs and processes. There are 250 clubs in Canada with 35,000 members.

The Board of Directors meet on a quarterly basis with on-line meetings but once a year they meet somewhere in Ontario as most of the clubs are in Ontario. Some areas have lost clubs and some areas have clubs that are bursting at the seams. The most item affecting a new club is the cost of a meeting location.
